PUBLIC CONSULTATION FOR AMENDING THE MEXICAN HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE

The Ministry of Economy has recently published on the web page of the integrated system of Foreign Trade Information (http://www.siiicex.gob.mx/portalSiiicex/actualiza/consulta_publica2017.htm), a Public Consultation for amending the Mexican Harmonized Tariff Schedule (HTS), in order to implement suggested changes made by the World Customs Organization, as well as complying with México's adopted commitments before the World Trade Organization regarding trade facilitation affairs.

The amendment project includes a mechanism for the creation of a code that entails the addition of a fifth pair of digits with the intention of offering more precise statistic information on foreign trade.

The suggestions, problematics and/or proposals about the codes and descriptions of the tariff codes could be submitted on the reception center for public support within the Ministry of Economy located in México City or through the e-mail address stated for such purposes. The deadline to submit comments is February 10th, 2017.

It is important to point out that the public consultation does not represent a duty review, therefore comments regarding the rates of the general import and export duties that are in force will not be taken into account.
